Education of Home Economics in Relation to the Great East Japan Earthquake

— Security of Foods and Radioactive Exposure —

Science on radioactive exposure has been controlled by persons who caused damages of radiation contamination generated from nuclear strategy and nuclear power plants. Especially, internal exposure has been ignored. Chernobyl law prohibits the residence and farm production in the contaminated area with more than radiation of 5mSv/year. In Japan, however, more than 1 million people live in the same contaminated area. Citizens are entitled to know the true damages of radioactive exposure, and must uphold human rights to be protected from radioactive internal exposure.
