To Seek and Establish Renaissance in Education

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- After the Great East-Japan Earthquake on March 11, 2011, changes of axis in education have occurred in the following two aspects, 1) to focus on respect for human rights, "put a top priority on life," and 2) to recognize the reality about danger of catastrophe.
- Reconstruction from extraordinary disasters means regional development with new values, and education for reconstruction means fostering students' ability to participate in reconstruction of a region.
- 3. It is noteworthy that explorations and challenges in home economics education include the following three perspectives, 1) to establish four elements in human life: life, livelihood, home and humanity, 2) to put learning into practice in the comprehensive, interdisciplinary, and problem-solving subject, and 3) to instill Renaissance in the central idea of the subject.
- 4. Renaissance in education fosters continues respect for human rights, and develops the backdrop in a tense situation with 'ancien regime'.

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
